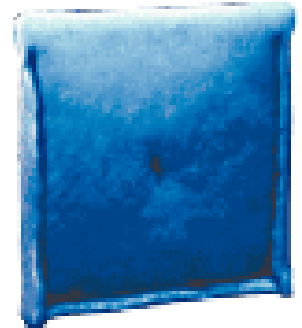
BOOTH FILTER TESTING

Unless you prove non-hazardous status, paint booth filters must be disposed of as hazardous waste.

Testing booth filters to demonstrate non-hazardous status is generally more cost effective.

Booth filters should be tested whenever there is a change in paint materials or booth maintenance practices.

EnviroSafe's process is easy.



When you are changing filters, cut a 8-inch x 8-inch sample, put in a zip-lock bag and ship via UPS to:
