## MANAGEMENT BULLETIN

### RESPIRATORY AIR QUALITY TESTING

Collision repair centers are required to implement a change schedule for respirators that is based on objective information or data that will ensure that canisters, cartridges, or respirators are changed before the end of their service life.



The air quality tests using the organic vapor monitor are the preferred testing method in the collision repair industry.



Here's how to do it:

1. Complete information below and fax to 847.740.1635.
2. You will receive via UPS an organic vapor monitor with the chain of custody documents partially completed.
3. Selected employee (probably lead painter) is to wear the monitor for 8 working hours – instructions included.
4. Follow the instructions included and return to EnviroSafe using the return label enclosed.
5. We will forward the monitor to the lab who will analyze the monitor and send test results to our office. We will review and determine the change schedule per 3M's recommendations.
6. You will receive a completed form with the recommended change schedule on organic vapors for your files.

**Retesting should occur if there are changes to the environment (concentration, ventilation, etc) or product changes.**
